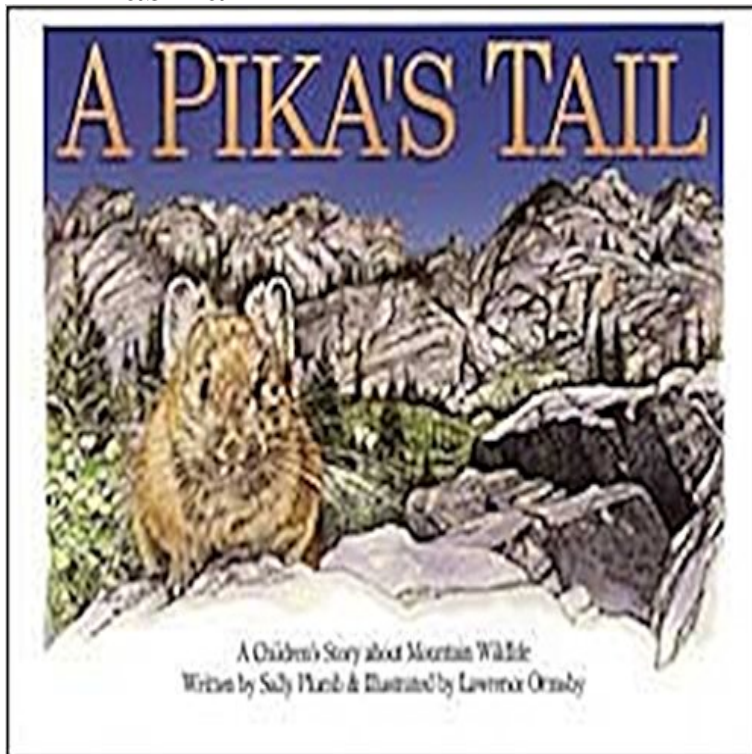


A Pikas Tail
