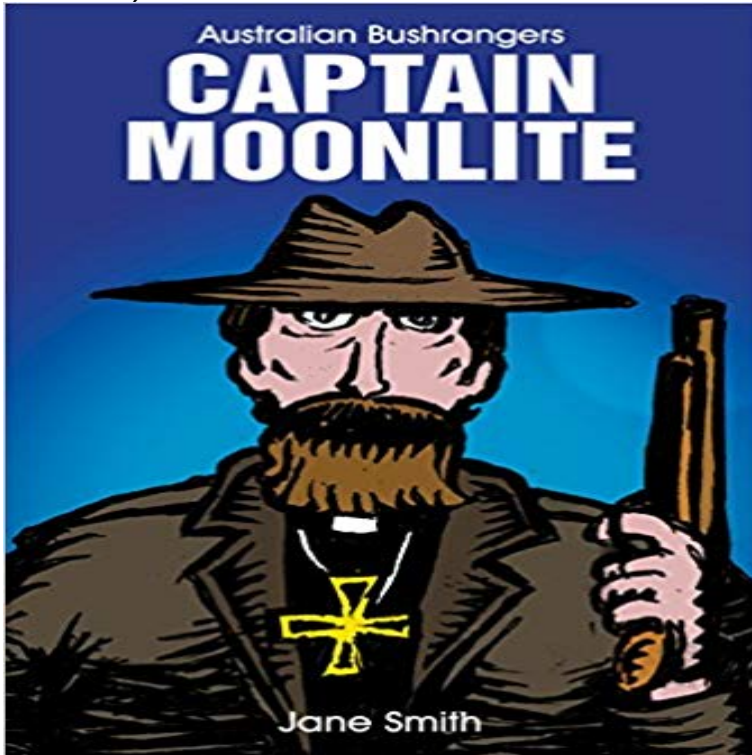


Australian Bushrangers - Captain Moonlite (Australian Bushrangers Series)



In 1869 Mt Egerton was outraged by the armed hold-up of the local bank by a masked villain calling himself Captain Moonlite. The shock deepened when the perpetrator turned out to be the new lay preacher, Andrew George Scott. On his release from prison Moonlite led a ragged bunch of young desperadoes to stage a siege that would end in a shoot-out and the death of a policeman. His death cell protestations of innocence raise doubts and sympathy in the hearts of some historians even today. This book tells the story of Captain Moonlite's life, from his birth in Ireland to his death on the gallows. These simply written, concise narratives provide an insight into the lives of these bushrangers. From their family background, crimes, family and gang members, the circumstances and events that led him to crime, and where relevant, his capture and death, the books are full of interesting facts and loaded with images, newspaper clippings and records.
