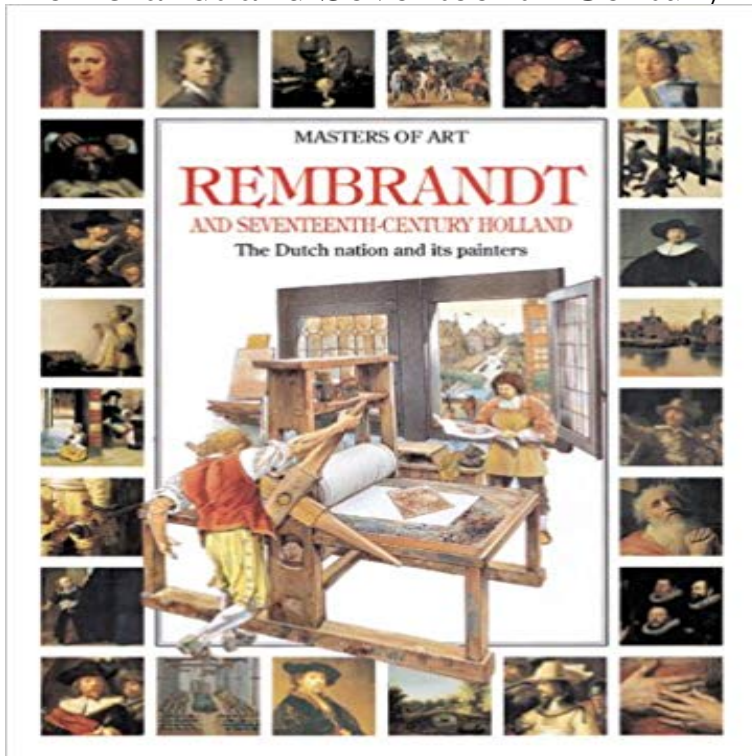


Rembrandt and Seventeenth-Century Holland (Masters of Art)
